

STEP 1 : SEARCH ON CGC WEBSITES: www.cgc.edu.in OR cgccoe.org.

STEP 2: CLICK ON ONLINE LIBRARY OR LIBRARY.

**STEP 3: IN SEARCH BAR:** 

- > SEARCH BY AUTHOR (SURNAME/FIRST NAME)
- > SEARCH BY TITLE (DON'T USE A, AN, THE)
- SEARCH BY KEYWORD

STEP 4 : SELECT THE BOOK OF YOUR CHOICE FROM YOUR CONCERNED LIBRARY ON THE RIGHT HAND SIDE FIELD (i.e., ALL) AND "GO".

STEP 5 : SELECT BROWSE : TO KNOW ABOUT COLLECTION BY AUTHOR , TITLE, CLASSIFIED, SUBJECT, PUBLISHER, PLACE.

STEP 6: SELECT MY ACCOUNT: TO KNOW ABOUT THE BOOKS YOU HAVE

- FACULTY WILL ENTER EMPLOYEE CODE AS USER ID & STUDENTS WILL ENTER ROLL NO. AS USER ID.
- PASSWORD IS SAME FOR ALL "cgclib".
- > AFTER LOGGING IN EVERYONE HAS THE OPTION TO CHANGE THEIR PASSWORD.
